



KIPP King Collegiate High School Uniform Policy

Monday through Thursday

Tops: Students must wear a KIPP King Collegiate High School shirt at all times, Monday-Thursday. Students also have the option to wear a plain royal blue or Black polo shirt with no logo that you may purchase on your own from any clothing store.

Bottoms: Khakis, Blue or Black Jeans are acceptable any day of the week. Ripped/Distressed Jeans and Leggings are not an acceptable alternative to jeans or pants, and are not part of the Uniform Monday-Friday, Leggings can only be worn under a dress, skirt or shorts. Skirts or shorts must never be shorter than 3" above the knee. No kind of undergarment should ever be visible.

Footwear: Students can wear any color closed toe shoe or sneaker. Opened toe shoes and athletic slides or sandals are not permitted to be worn on campus.

Outerwear: All outerwear (sweatshirts and jackets) must be either a KIPP King hoodie, KIPP King Knit Letterman Jacket, or a Kipp King zip up. Students may also wear any non KIPP King outerwear as long as it is all Black. If the Outerwear does have a logo on it, the logo must be under 5 inches in height and width. In cooler weather students may wear long sleeved t-shirts or sweat shirts underneath their King uniform shirts for extra warmth. Students must wear a KIPP King Uniform Shirt at all times Monday- Thursday even underneath the permitted outerwear.

PE Uniform: All freshman students are required to participate in Physical Education. And must wear the King uniform during P.E instruction. The uniform consists of the following; King Athletic T-shirt and King Athletic Blue shorts, Comfortable Sneakers. No outerwear is required. Students can wear a long-sleeved shirt underneath their King athletic P.E shirt for extra warmth, or athletic leggings under the King P.E shorts. A regular KIPP King uniform T-shirt is not acceptable as an alternative to the required Athletic P.E T-shirt.

Friday Dress Code

All Students have a free dress day every Friday and must follow the King dress code. Students may wear any type of shirt and any color outerwear. Friday clothes must meet the the following requirements: No Midriff/Belly should be visible at any time at KIPP King. No spaghetti straps or tank tops. No athletic slides or sandals. No clothing with homophobic, racially discriminating, sexist logos. No images or logos of drug paraphernalia. Ripped/Distressed Jeans & Leggings are not part of the uniform policy at KIPP King, and should not be worn Monday-Friday. Leggings may only be worn under a dress, skirt or shorts. Skirts or shorts must never be shorter than 3" above the knee. No kind of undergarment should ever be visible.
