Happy Lunar New Year! Here at KIPP King, we had an incredibly exciting start to 2020. On January 17, 2020, we held our First Annual Day of Service in honor of our school's namesake, Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. All 715 students and staff participated in service projects around the Bay Area, and joyously affirmed Dr. King's message that, "**anyone can be great because anyone can serve.**" We look forward to building on this experience next year, and inviting our parent community to join in our celebration of an incredible legacy of fighting for social justice.

Additionally, this week we opened a brand new \$2 million dollar turf athletic facility that will serve as our home field for our soccer teams, and as a practice facility for our baseball and softball teams. We celebrated our opening with a ribbon cutting by our sports captains, and the Class of 2020 had the opportunity to take the field first. ### **FYI | Class of 2020 Graduation & Senior Events**

Summative English Language Proficiency Assessments for California (ELPAC) testing will begin in February. Students who are identified as English Language Learners will complete assessments in four domains: Listening, Speaking, Reading, and Writing. This year the test will be almost entirely computer based, so all students should have charged chromebooks at all times! The test is used to measure how well students understand English when it is not their primary language. Information from the ELPAC helps our teachers provide support in the right areas.
